Extracts from 1881 Census. (taken on Sunday April 3rd)

Think of Lymm in the 1880s and we perhaps think first of gentry and servants, of fustian cutters and farmers. But there was another community who made their home in Lymm and district or were frequent village visitors -boatmen and their families.

There is a commonly held misconception that boatmen always lived on their boats with their families. This was certainly not so in the early days but gradually families were forced to onto their boats in the late 1800s as competition from railways drove down rates of pay.

There are around fifty families listed here. Sixteen of them include a boat name and are at canal side locations. It is likely that these people were counted on their boat. It shows just how busy the canal was at Lymm and how many used it is a stopping place. Another 34 families though appear to be permanent addresses in the village.


